

BIO OF HON. TIMOTHY J. DUFFICY

Timothy Dufficy is currently a Supreme Court Justice in Queens County, assigned to the court's Civil Term, and tries all civil matters, including labor law, negligence and medical malpractice, as well as handling complex criminal matters. He previously served in the New York City Civil Court, and Criminal Court in Brooklyn, Queens, and Staten Island. He has had clerkships with various Supreme Court judges and served as an Assistant District Attorney for three years.

Timothy J. Dufficy was raised and schooled in Queens County. His parents John F. Dufficy and Ann B. Dufficy lived in Queens County for 60 years. Ann B. Dufficy, a naval officer in World War II, met John F. Dufficy, a fellow naval officer and Lieutenant Comander and they married in 1944. Ann was a Queens County Supreme Court Justice and John worked as an attorney in the New York State Court system.

After graduating Queens College, Justice Dufficy attended St. John's Law School and graduated in two and one-half years. After law school, he worked for the law firm of Manton, Pennisi & Dowd.

Justice Dufficy has maintained a residence in the Breezy Point area for the past 50 years. He is married to Mary Dufficy and has two children, Timothy, a member of Local 30, and Doreen, an attorney, and has one grandchild, Payton.

He presently serves as a Trustee of Jamaica Hospital and Medysis Corporation, and is a member of the Association of Supreme Court Justices of the State of New York, the Assistant District Attorneys' Association of Queens County, and the Law Alumni Association of St. John's School of Law. He has hosted Wounded Warriors at his home and aided Rockaway Point yacht club in its Wounded Warrior Aquatic Program.
